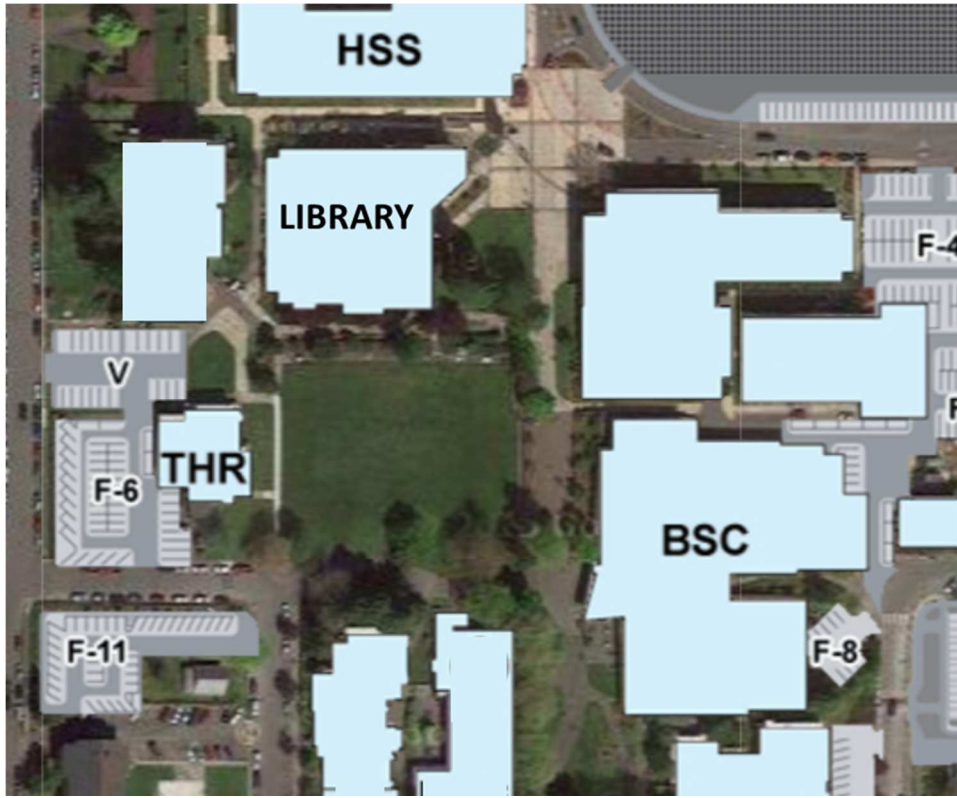

- ◆ Choose the breakout sessions you will attend **and go**. It's okay to change your mind or get lost. If you need help, ask any adult with a bright green name tag.



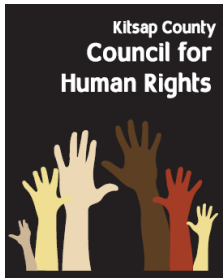
