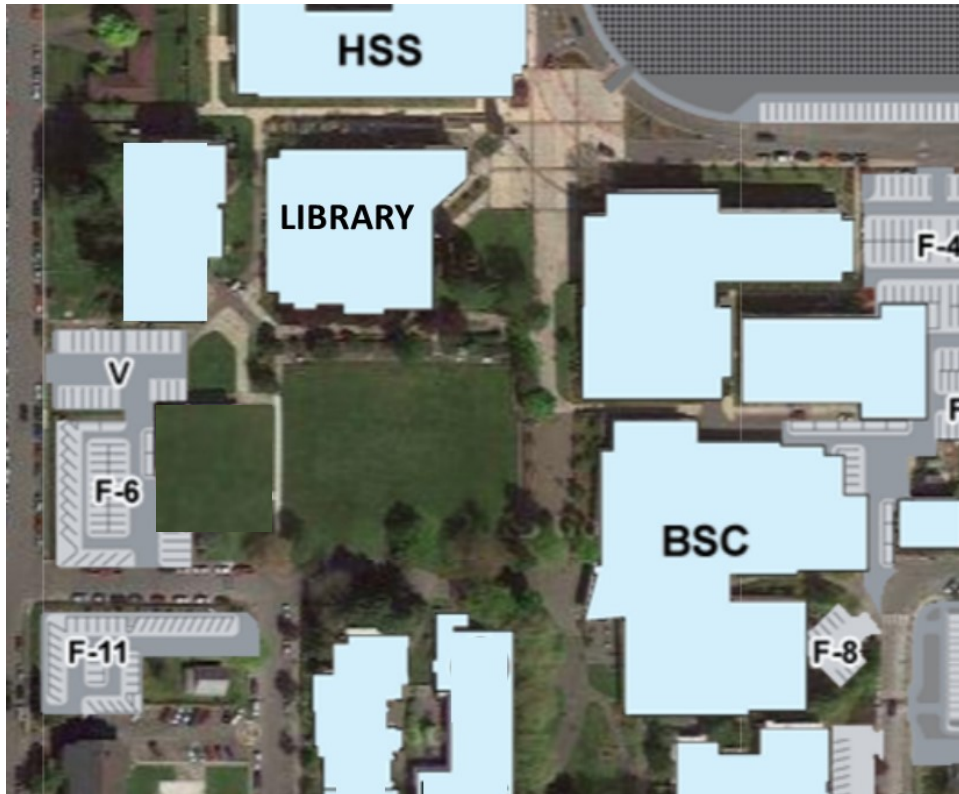
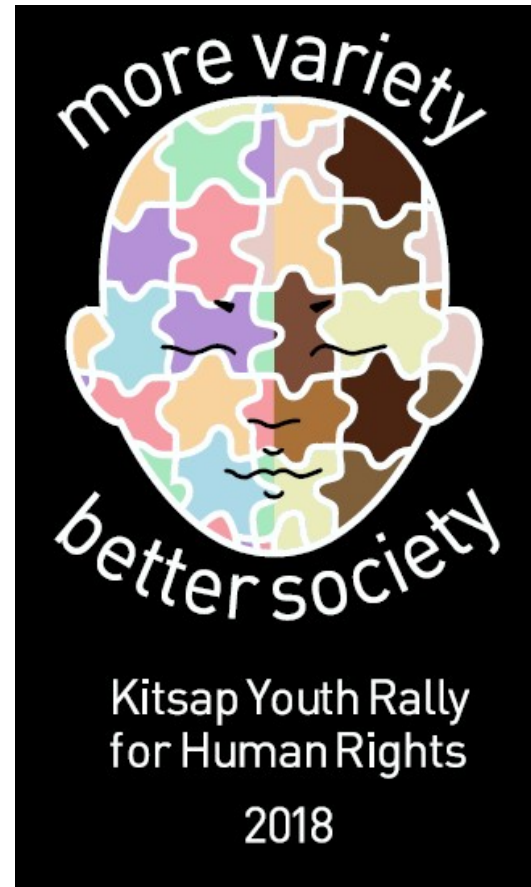

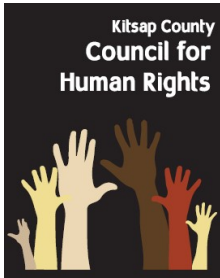
- ◆ YOU are the focus of this event. It is important that you be respectful, learn something new, and have fun.
